

ENTRY & BERTHING

Entry will be via the Spirit Yachts website once the Notice of Race has been finalised by the RCNP race management. All entrants will be required to submit an IRC certificate in advance of the event.

All Spirit yachts will be berthed together in front of the yacht club, larger yachts will be on E10 pontoon, to the left of the terrace.

Each yacht is required to send an email to the RCNP Capitania with: duration of berthing, boat insurance, and crew list. capitania@rcnp.es

x1 van on the RCNP pontoon to load/unload and x1 dockbox per yacht are permitted. Additional onshore storage details to follow.

The regatta is designed to deliver value on the water and ashore.

Entry and social fees (payable on entry to the regatta):

Spirit 46 and 52	Racing and berthing: 2,400 euros
Spirit 60+	Racing and berthing: 3,300 euros
Social events	200 euros per person

Racing and berthing includes:

Berthing from 1400 on 22 October to 1200 on 27 October

Four race series across four days, managed by RCNP

Social events ticket includes:

Wednesday: welcome drinks and canapés

Friday: Mallorcan tapas and two course dinner with open bar (beer, wine, and cava)

Saturday: three course dinner, welcome drink, and open bar (beer, wine and cava)

Sunday: pizzas and beers at prize giving
